Ciara began trampolining with CETC at the end of 2008 and began competing the following year. In 2010 she qualified for her first Scottish Nationals, and in 2011 she competed at her first British Gala series for DMT, and in the 2012 season began competing trampolining. At the 2012 Home Nations event, she was selected for both synchro and DMT, and then in the 2014 Home Nations for DMT and trampolining, where she won Junior DMT.

In 2015, Ciara was selected for the Junior GB DMT Squad and won the 17-18 DMT girls group at the 2015 British Championships. She then went on to represent GB at the World Age Groups in Denmark.

At the start of 2016, Ciara was selected for her first senior GB competition, and took part in the European Championships in Spain, where she won a bronze medal with the GB Senior women's DMT Team.

Ciara has qualified for Senior Womens DMT at this year's British Championships, which will be held in Birmingham in September.

She has also recently been selected to represent Scotland at the Loule Cup in Portugal in October 2019.

Since 2017 Ciara has been studying at Robert Gordon University in Aberdeen to complete her physiotherapy degree, but coaches & trains with the Club when she's home over the holidays.

She is hoping to complete her modules 1 and 2 of UKCC level 3 soon, and then go on to complete a Senior club coach DMT course in the near future as well.
