Kirsten joined CETC in 2019, and as well as trampolining, has taken up DMT, and represented her country at the Inter Regional Challenge Cup in 2022.

She has always been interested in coaching, and started off with the Learn to Coach programme, but as soon as she was 16 she started her Level 1 coaching qualification, gaining her certificate in August 2023.

Kirsten particularly loves coaching the little ones, and is keen to pass on her knowledge to the next generation of bouncers.

Kirsten is currently a cover coach whilst at University.
